- Arrange for someone to care for your children and household if you are arrested or detained.
- Make sure your key documents are in a safe place.

Know Your Rights

1) You have the right to **remain silent, not answer questions**, **and not sign any documents**.

2) You have the right to **ask to speak with an attorney**.

3) You have the right to **clearly state if you are afraid to go back to your country of origin**.

4) You have the right to **ask to speak with the consulate from your country of citizenship.**
